- Author name¹, Author name², etc. (full name, centred)
- Paper title (lower case, bold, centred)
- Position (full job title, centred)
- Author affiliation (full, centred)
- Text

Contributions (12000 – 15000 characters including spaces) should be submitted online:

- ✓ Word format
- ✓ Font – Times New Roman, 14 pt
- ✓ Single-spaced 14 pt interline spacing
- ✓ The top, bottom, right and left margins should be 2,5 cm
- ✓ Paragraph indent – 1 cm
- ✓ Centered
- ✓ Language: English

Please, use *italics* and **bold** for text highlights.

Illustrations should be submitted in one of the common image formats (.jpg, .tiff).

References should be located one line after the main text and cited according to the *Unified Style for Linguistics journals* https://www.linguisticsociety.org/sites/default/files/style-sheet_0.pdf. List your references in alphabetical order. If the list contains several works by the same author, arrange them in chronological order.

The organizing committee reserves the right to edit the submitted materials and return them to the author for revision/editing.

QS Subject Focus Summit 2020 “Languages and Migration in a Globalized World” proceedings will be indexed in RSCI (Russian Science Citation Index)

The best reports will be published in **“Russian Journal of Linguistics” (Scopus Q2)**.
